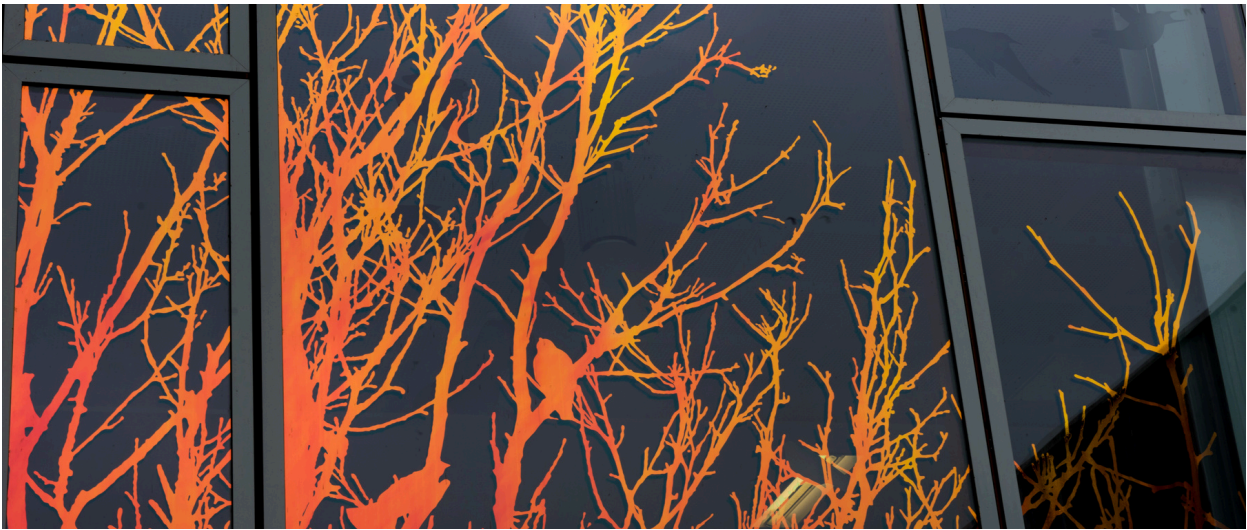


Cowbridge School Newsletter
