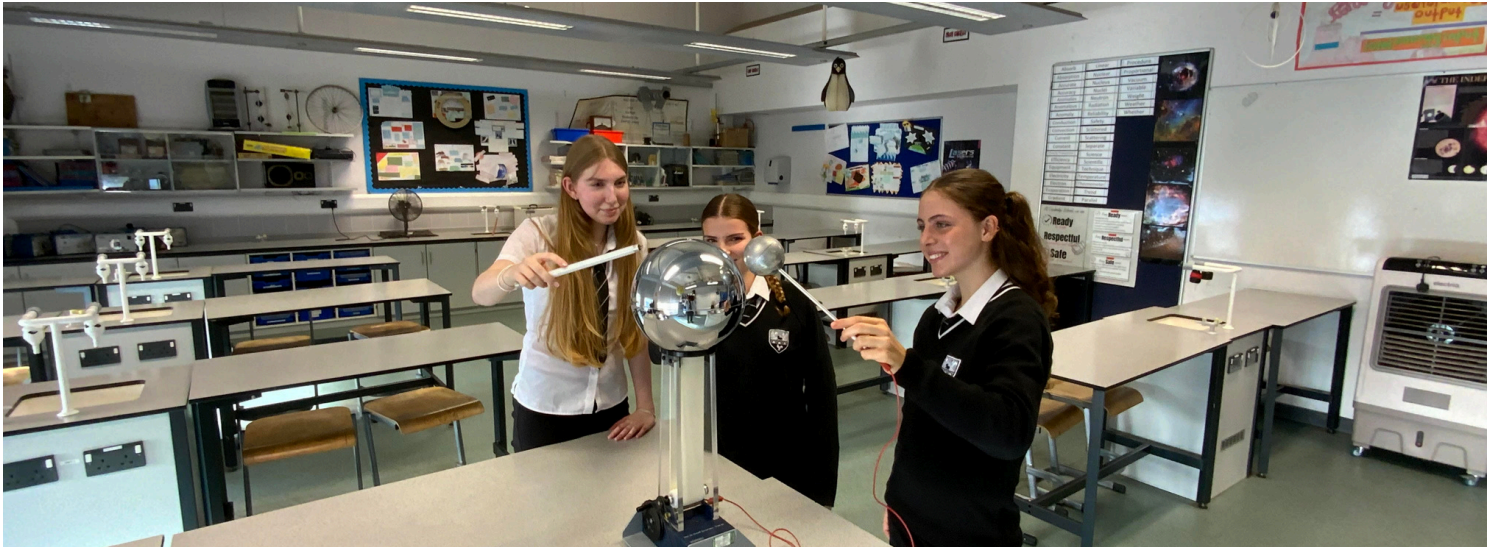


# Cowbridge School Newsletter
