Nursery have been learning all about sunflowers. They have looked at the beautiful painting by Vincent van Gogh and then made their own observational paintings of sunflowers. Reception have also been busy with plants this week. They are hoping to have green fingers and grow some sunflowers as well as potatoes! They have been identifying similarities and differences between different plants and even carried out their own science experiment to find out where the water goes.
